

# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

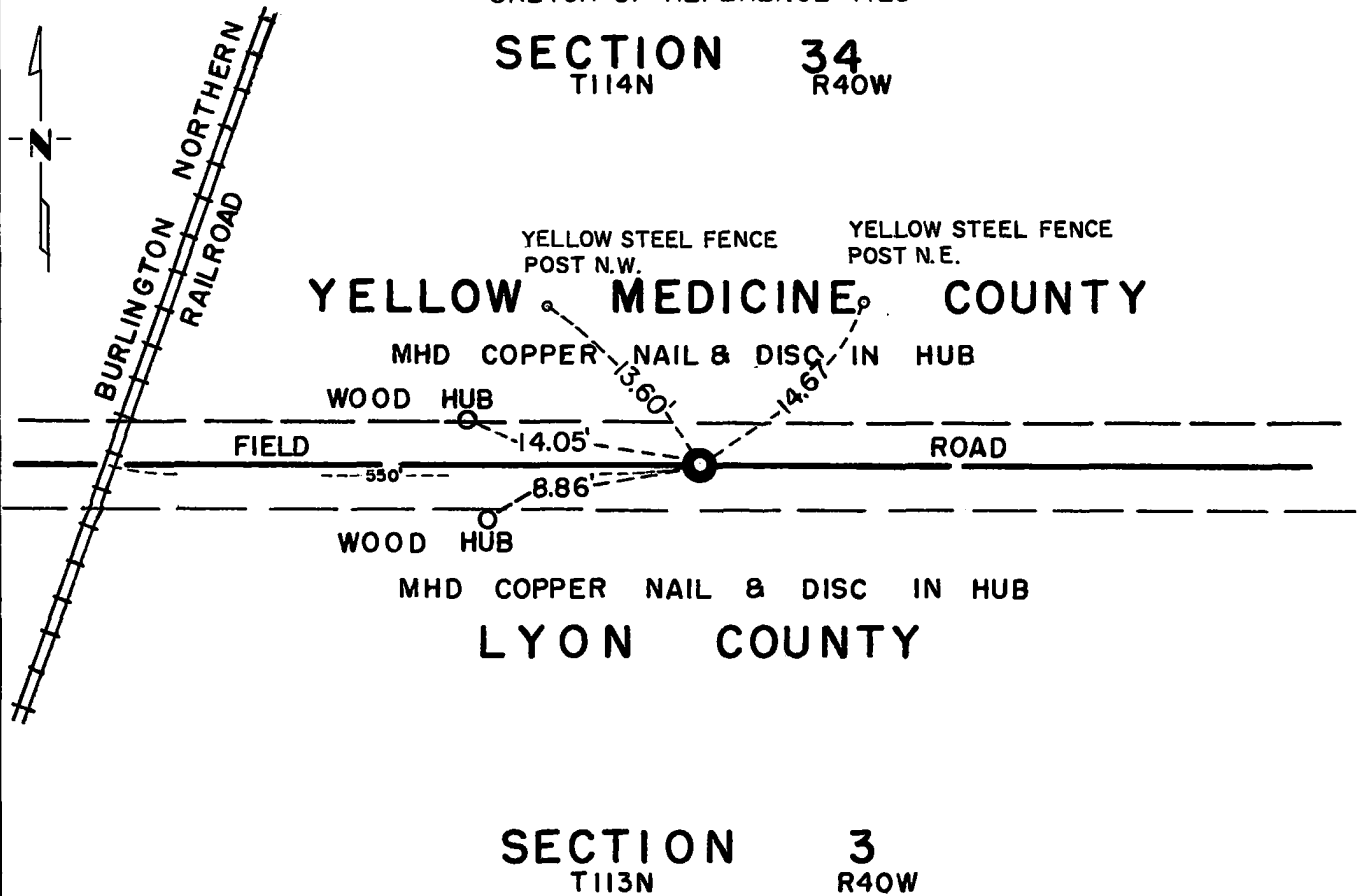

At the corner location shown on the sketch:

- On July 28, 1972 found a 6 inch x 8 inch x 18 inch limestone monument with a  
DATE 4 inch x 6 inch x 8 inch field stone & wood hub down 2.0 feet.  
 left monument as found,  lowered monument,  removed monument (explain)
  
- On July 28, 1972 placed a Minnesota Highway Department cast iron monument on  
DATE top of limestone monument (down 0.3 feet).

Statement of Evidence: SOUTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 34, T114N, R40W

The original Public Land Survey for the township line was run in 1858 and a wood post was set in a mound with pits to mark the corner.

In 1916 John Norgaard, County Surveyor, set a stake to mark the corner on line and equal distances between section corners.

On July 28, 1972 Minnesota Highway Department found a 6 inch x 6 inch x 18 inch cut limestone monument with a wood stake and field stone alongside it.

The origin of the limestone monument could not be determined. An analysis of the record data compared to the 1972 field measurements indicates that the limestone monument is in agreement with past surveys and is accepted as the location of the Public Land Survey Corner.
