

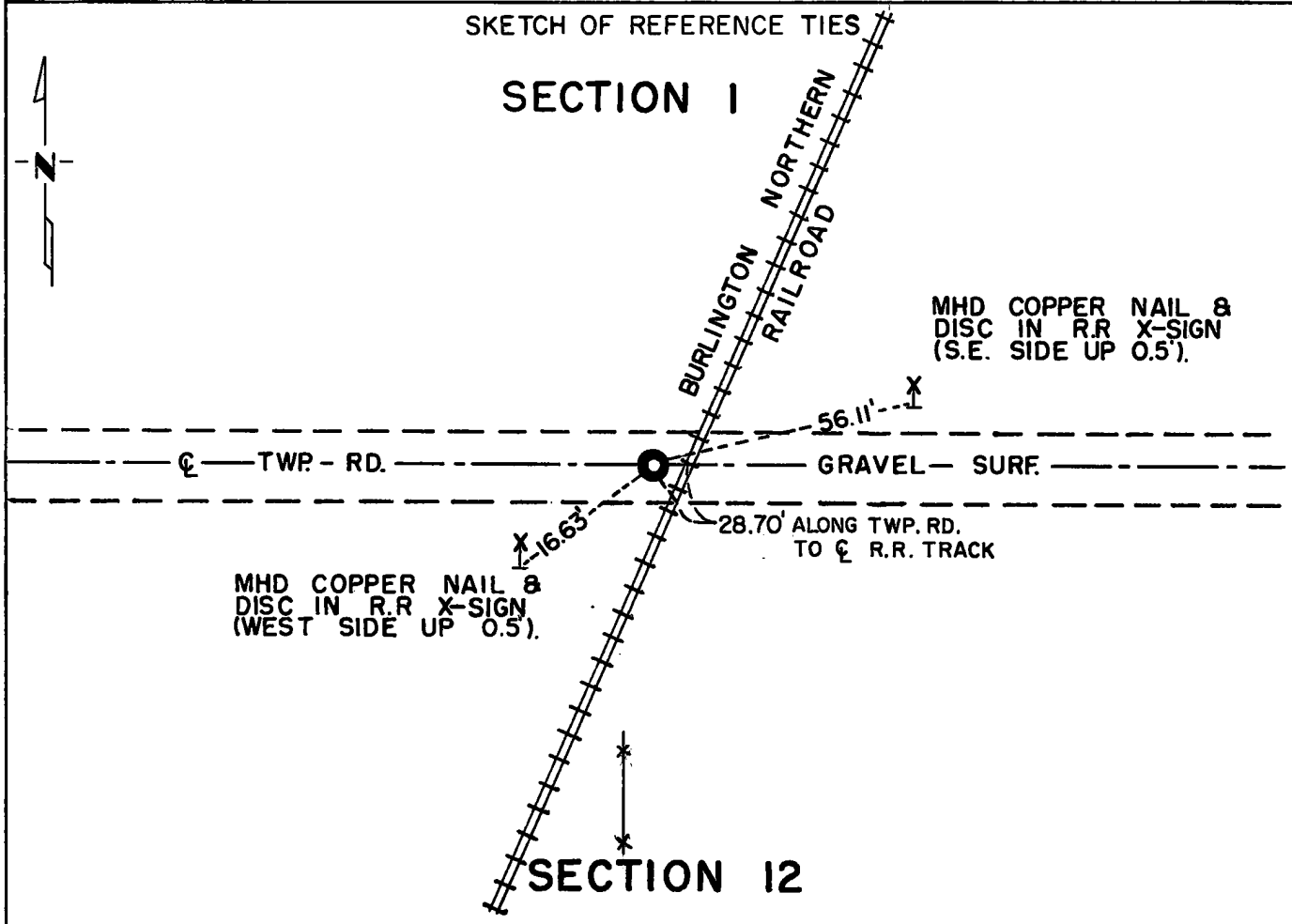
CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

- On Nov. 1, 1972 found a 1½ inch round wood stake laying on its side

Statement of Evidence: NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 12, T114N, R40W

The original Public Land Survey was run in 1858 and a wood post was set in a mound with the pits to mark the corner.

In 1874 Ole Quam found the original post.

On November 1, 1972, the Minnesota Highway Department found a 1½" round wood stake lying on its side on centerline of East-West road and 2' East of fence line south.

On November 3, 1972, the Minnesota Highway Department placed a cast iron monument at the location of the wood stake.

An analysis of the record data compared to the 1972 field measurements indicates that the 1½" round wood stake is in the accepted location of the Public Land Survey corner.
