Statement of Evidence: NORTHEAST CORNER SECTION 9, T115N, R39W, 5TH P.M.

The original Public Land Survey was completed in 1864 by Charles E. Davis and J. W. Webb Jr. A wood post was set in a mound of dirt with pits to mark the corner.

In 1901, John Norgaard, County Surveyor, found a stake and a stone in the government mound. He set a  $6" \times 6" \times 24"$  granite monument at this location at that time.

An analysis of this data provides a continuous chain of record perpetuation the location of the original Public Land Survey corner.
