Statement of Evidence: NORTHEAST CORNER SECTION 7, T115N, R40W

In 1895 and 1901 John E. Norgaard found a stone inplace. In 1901 he replaced the stone with a 6 inch x 6 inch x 24 inch jasper monument.

Prior to 1956 the Minnesota Highway Department right of way map shows a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch iron rod inplace.

On May 22, 1974 the Minnesota Highway Department found the $\frac{1}{2}$ inch iron rod on centerline of North-South road and 1.0 foot North of centerline of East-West highway (T.H. 67).

I could not determine who replaced the jasper monument with the $\frac{1}{2}$ inch iron rod.

On July 19, 1974 the Minnesota Highway Department placed a cast iron monument with 3/4 inch iron pin below it to mark the corner.
