1911 October, pages 251 and 252 of a Surveyor's Record Book, obtained from the County Recorder's Office, contain surveys by John Norgaard, County Surveyor. Surveys show corner but do not indicate what kind of monument was found or set. The corner is shown:

2640 feet from the north quarter corner of Section 23

5280 feet from the northeast corner of Section 23

5292 feet from the northeast corner of Section 27

1913 August, page 297 of a Surveyor's Record Book, obtained from the County Recorder's Office, contains a survey by John Norgaard. Survey shows corner but does not indicate what kind of monument was found or set. The corner is shown:

2637 feet from the north quarter corner of Section 23 5274 feet from the northeast corner of Section 23

No Section Corner Tie Book, obtained from the County Highway Engineer's Office, does not indicate what kind of monument was found or set at corner but the following ties are shown to it:

fence post, northwest, 63.8 feet fence post, southeast, 93.2 feet second steel fence post, northeast, 69.3 feet

May 1, DNR Bureau of Engineering hired a backhoe to dig for evidence of the corner. A bridge spike was found down 0.3 of a foot over a 6" by 6" cut granite stone down 3.9 feet. Discarded the found bridge spike and set a 3/4" by 24" rebar with plastic cap stamped "MN DNR LS 17003" over the cut granite stone. Searched for but found no evidence of the record ties. The 6" by 6" cut granite stone was found to be:

5277.48 feet from the northeast corner of Section 23 5292.71 feet from the northeast corner of Section 27

Analysis of the above information led the DNR Bureau of Engineering to conclude that the 6" by 6" cut granite stone marks the location of the corner.
