U. S. General Land Office notes, obtained from the South Dakota Historical Society's Office, show the corner marked with a six inch square by eight foot long wood post in a 3 ½ foot high by 5 ½ inch diameter mound with trenches 18 inches east and west. The following was marked on the wood post:

"Minnesota" on the east

"Dakota" on the west

"1859" on the south

"36M" on the north

- 1902 September, pages 48 and 49 of a Surveyor's Field Book, obtained from the Deuel County Register of Deed's Office, contain field notes of G.W. Carpenter's (County and Deputy State Surveyor) resurvey of all the mile posts abutting Deuel County between the states of South Dakota and Minnesota and all of the section and quarter section corners abutting and pertaining to Deuel County. The field notes state that a stone in a mound with 2 pits were found at corner. The stone was replaced with a 6 inch by 6 inch by 30 inch granite stone which was set firmly in the ground.
- 2000 May 10, DNR Bureau of Engineering traversed to the area of the corner and found a 6 inch by 6 inch cut granite stone flush with the ground with a 1 inch by 12 inch iron rod along its northeast edge. The cut granite stone was found to be:

18.5 feet east of a north-south fence

5283.96 feet from Mile Post Number 37

Analysis of the above information led the DNR Bureau of Engineering to conclude that the found 6 inch by 6 inch cut granite stone marks the original location of the corner.
