



East Quarter Corner of Section 33, Township 114 North, Range 46 West

The DNR Bureau of Engineering contacted the following for survey information:

Minnesota Secretary of State's Office

Yellow Medicine County Recorder's Office

Yellow Medicine County Highway Engineer's Office

- 1871 U. S. General Land Office notes obtained from the Secretary of State's Office show the corner marked with a wood post in a raised mound as per instructions.
- 1913 A page in a Surveyor's Record Book, obtained from the County Recorder's Office, contains a survey by John Norgaard, County Surveyor. Survey shows corner but does not indicate what kind of monument was found or set. The corner is shown:  
2643 feet from the northeast corner of Section 33  
2637 feet from the southeast corner of Section 33
- 2000 October 10, DNR Bureau of Engineering traversed to the area of corner and found a 16 inch diameter field stone flush with the ground on the center line of an old washed out road. Searched the area for other stones but did find any. The stone was found to be:  
2643.04 feet from the northeast corner of Section 33  
2641.39 feet from the southeast corner of Section 33  
11.27 feet east of a straight line between adjoining section corners  
0.90 of a foot south and 11.27 feet east of the lost position per GLO survey  
2.10 feet north and 11.29 feet east of the lost position per 1913 survey

Analysis of the above information led the DNR Bureau of Engineering to conclude that the found 16 inch diameter field stone marks the location of the corner. To aid in finding the stone in the future a 3/4 inch by 12 inch rebar was set down 0.2 of a foot on its south side.
