

North Quarter Corner of Section 33, Township 114 North, Range 46 West

The DNR Bureau of Engineering contacted the following for survey information:

Minnesota Secretary of State's Office

Yellow Medicine County Recorder's Office

Yellow Medicine County Highway Engineer's Office

- 1871 U. S. General Land Office notes obtained from the Secretary of State's Office show the corner marked with a wood post in a raised mound as per instructions.
- 1913 A page in a Surveyor's Record Book, obtained from the County Recorder's Office, contains a survey by John Norgaard, County Surveyor. Survey shows corner but does not indicate what kind of monument was found or set. The corner is shown:
2644 feet from the northeast corner of Section 33
2644 feet from the northwest corner of Section 33
- 2000 October 10, DNR Bureau of Engineering hired a backhoe to dig for evidence of the corner. A 9 inch triangular shaped stone was found down 1.4 feet. Set a 3/4" by 12" rebar with an aluminum cap stamped "DNR SURVEY MARKER" over the stone and found it to be:
on the center line of an east-west Township Road
in line with a fence north
2651.66 feet from the northeast corner of Section 33
2648.94 feet from the northwest corner of Section 33
5.11 feet south and 1.41 feet west of the lost position

Analysis of the above information led the DNR Bureau of Engineering to conclude that the found 9 inch triangular shaped stone marks the location of the corner.
