

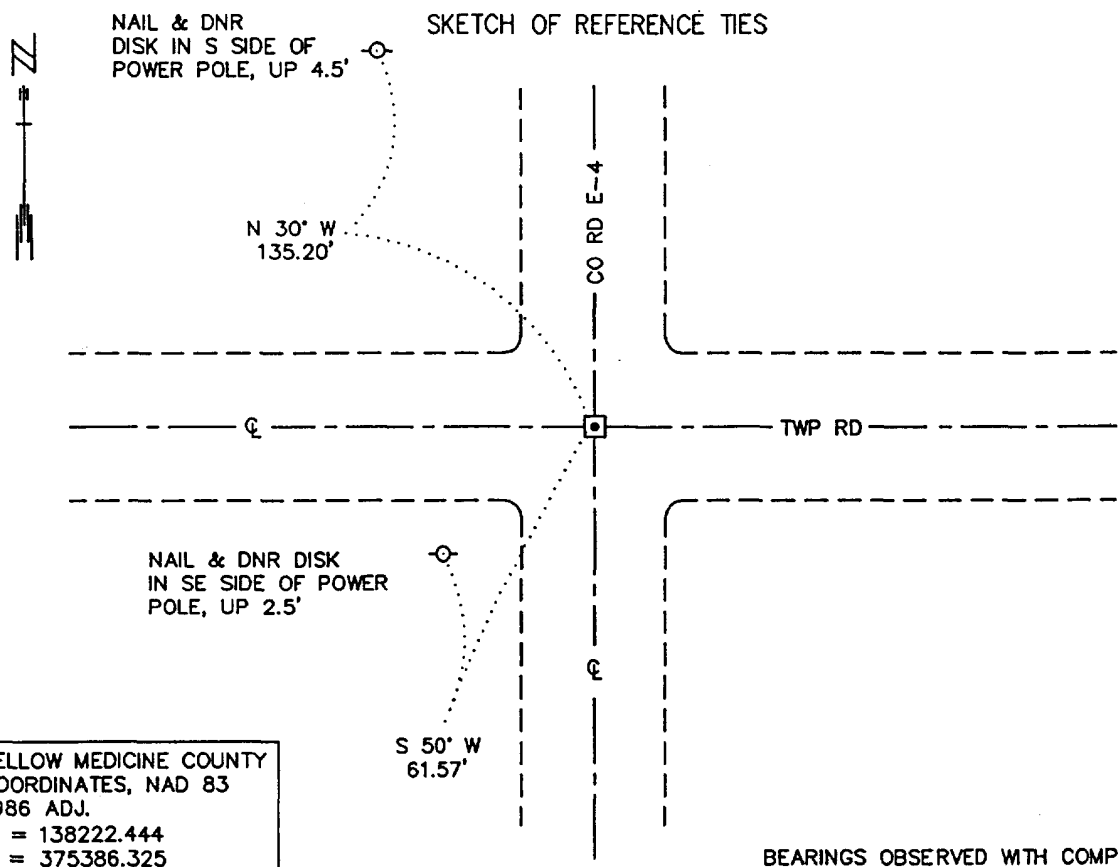
CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

The DNR Bureau of Engineering contacted the following for survey information:

Minnesota Secretary of State's Office
Yellow Medicine County Recorder's Office
Yellow Medicine County Highway Engineer's Office

- 1871 U. S. General Land Office notes obtained from the Secretary of State's Office show the corner marked with a wood post in a raised mound as per instructions.
- 1901 Surveyor's Record Book B contains John Norgaard's, County Surveyor, remonumentation notes for section corners in Yellow Medicine County. The following information is stated about corner on page 203:
found stone in the government mound
set a 6 inch by 6 inch by 24 inch long jasper granite level with the ground to mark corner
- 1909 May, Surveyor's Record Book, page 198, obtained from the County Recorder's Office, contains a survey by John Norgaard, County Surveyor. Survey shows that a stone monument was found at corner. The corner is shown:
2636 feet from the north quarter corner of Section 34
2638 feet from the east quarter corner of Section 34
5276 feet from the southeast corner of Section 34
- No Section Corner Tie Book, page 4, obtained from the County Highway Engineer's Office, does not
Date indicate what kind of monument was found or set at corner but the following ties are shown to it:
third fence post, southeast, 76.5 feet
first fence post, northeast, 80.5 feet
hub, northwest, 84.4 feet
- 2000 October 10, DNR Bureau of Engineering hired a backhoe to dig for evidence of the corner. A 6 inch by 6 inch cut granite stone was found down 1.3 feet. Searched for but found no evidence of the record ties. Set a 3/4 inch by 12 inch rebar with aluminum cap stamped "DNR SURVEY MAKER" over the cut granite stone and found it to be:
at the intersection of the center lines of roads north, south, east and west
2635.81 feet from the north quarter corner of Section 34
2640.90 feet from the east quarter corner of Section 34
5281.80 feet from the southeast corner of Section 34

Analysis of the above information led the DNR Bureau of Engineering to conclude that the found 6 inch by 6 inch cut granite stone marks the original location of the corner.
