Statement of Evidence

In May 1914, John Nordgaard, recorded setting the corner on line and equal distance between section corners.

On November 7, 1979, Southwest Engineering (Willard Pellinen), found a 3" semi-circle iron bar and is 3.5 feet longer than the recorded distance, but equal distance ± 0.5 feet between section corners.

On June 19, 2001, Moseng Land Surveying found 3' semi-circle iron bar from the notes of Willard Pellinen.
