STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

East Quarter Corner Section 19, T114N-R44W

1871

L. Harrington was contracted by the United States Government Land Office to perform the Original Public Land Survey in this township. He records in his field notes, "Set a post for 1/4 sec cor and raised mound as per instructions."

1899-1901

John Norgaard, County Surveyor, records in the County Survey Record Book B, page 39, that he measured to the corner while doing a re-survey of section corners across the county at the request of the Co. Board.

March 22 -April 29, 2010 Gary L. Kratz, Regional Land Surveyor, for the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, while performing work in the SE $\!\!\!/\!\!\!4$ of Section 20, states in his field notes that he Set a $\!\!\!/\!\!\!2$ " x $\!\!\!\!1$ 6" iron pipe down 3" and dimensions to the northeast and southeast corners of this section. He further notes on his section breakdown sheet that he set this corner using "single proportion, hit fences E + W." He also established 2 section corner witness ties.

July 30, 2012

Duane A. Bonnema, LS 14895, while doing a re-monumentation survey for the Minnesota Department of Transportation located a ½" iron pipe at the road surface at the corner position. With the aid of a MnDOT backhoe he excavated a 4.5' deep hole that covered an area extending 6.0' North, 5.0' South, 4.0' East, 1.0' West of this Section Corner location. At a depth of 2.2' he found a Square Topped ¾" diameter iron rod. At a depth of 3' he found a piece of charred oak stake. The original topsoil appeared to be at a depth of 1.5'. The Square Topped ¾" diameter iron rod and piece of charred oak stake verified the location of the ½" Iron Pipe. A Cast Iron capped 2" x 30" Telspar Iron Monument was placed at the location of the ½" iron pipe that was found at the surface.
