## North Quarter Corner Section 15, T114N-R45W

1871

L. Harrington was contracted by the United States Government Land Office to perform the Original Public Land Survey in this township. He records in his field notes "Set a post for 1/4 sec cor and raised mound as per instructions".

Nov 6, 1891

Jonah Peterman, County Surveyor, records in County Surveyor's Record Book, page 52, "I found all of the Quarter posts in and to said Section 10" and "Government found" at this corner position. He also notes he "set stone" at the center of this section.

I.M. Youngdahl, records in County Surveyor's Record Book, page 397 "N/4 post Nothing Found."

March 7, 2013

Matthew D. Runke, LS 46171, while doing afre-monumentation survey for Minnesota Department of Transportation, searched an area extending 25' North, 25' South, 25' East and 25' West of a straight line and split position with a metal locator and found nothing. This corner was not excavated Due to the 122 year gap in survey activity, records and perpetuation of this corner position. Runke searched for, and did not find the stone set at the center of Section 10 by Peterman in 1891. There is an old cemetery fence corner at the center of section, and holding with a straight line and split position at the N¼ corner of this section, the fence corner would be within 1.5' of the quarter line. In 1918 Youngdahl was unable to recover this corner position and it appears that a fence line has recently been removed and earthwork done in this area that would have removed any remaining evidence of this corner position. A Cast Iron capped 2"x30" Telspar Monument was placed midway and online between the northeast and northwest corner of this section. This position matches well with the fence lines to the north and south and the old cemetery fence corner at the center of section.
