David Watson was contracted by the United States Government Land Office to perform the Original Public Land Survey in this township. Watson records in his field notes that he "Set 1/4 post in mound with pits & chd stks."

Unknown Date

John Norgaard, County Surveyor, records in the County Surveyor's Record Book, page 392 a dimensions from the northeast corner of Section 16 to the northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 16 and then from the northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 16 to the northwest corner of Section 16.

Mar. 3, 2014

Joshua M. Stern, LS 46169, searched with a metal locator at this corner position and found nothing. He also searched for the 1/16th corner called for by Norgaard and found nothing. Norgaard's overall mile distance matches todays distance within 2 feet, confirming the northeast and northwest corners of this section. Norgaard's math shows he split the mile into 4 equal distances. An Iron Rod with a "46169 46171" stamped plastic cap was set on a straight line between the northeast and northwest corners of this section and at the Norgaard mathematical split position. No large excavation was done for this corner due to the large amount of frost and because it falls within the road surface.
