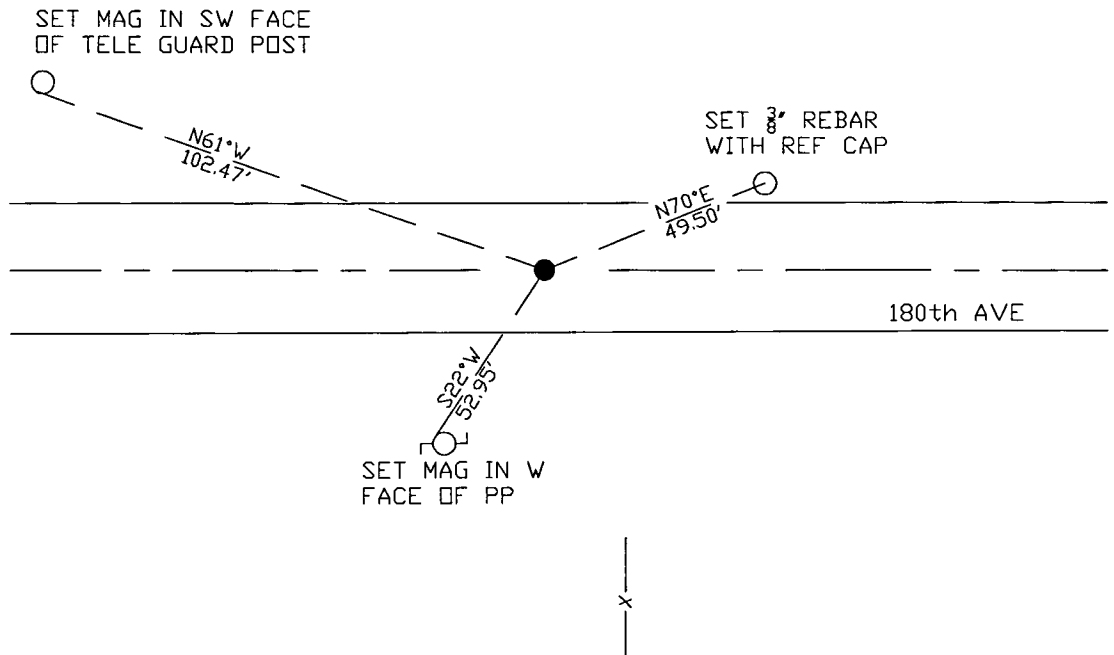

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE:

NORTH QUARTER OF SECTION 29, T114N, R46W, 5TH PM

1871 Corner was originally established by the U.S. General Land Office as a post set in raised mound.

1920 Surveyors Record Book page 436, corner set online and equal distance between Section Corners (2615').

Undated Surveyors Record Book page 457 has ties as follows:

Box Elder 12" SE 42.0'

Cottonwood 15" NE 39.6'

2008 Roy Marihart completed a survey for Sections 19+20 in which he found a monument at the S1/4 corner Section 20.

2017-10-25 Westwood PS searched the area and found 1/2" rebar, which fits within 1 ft to the 1920 survey distances and also fits the location from 2008 survey. Accepting monument as the corner location and set 3 reference ties.
