



STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE:

NORTHEAST OF SECTION 19, T114N, R46W, 5TH PM

*1871 Corner was originally established by the U.S. General Land Office as a post set in raised mound.*

*1965 MN Conservation Department completed a survey in which they set a RR spike at the SW corner Section 17 and measured 5193.7' to the NW corner Section 17.*

*1977 Lyle Moseng filed a corner record dated 07/12/1983 in which a #4 rebar with seal was set over a found jasper stone.*

*2008 Roy Marihart completed a survey for Sections 19+20 in which he found a monument at the NE corner Section 19.*

*2017-10-17 Westwood PS received coordinates for this corner location from the County Highway Department.*

*2017-10-25 Westwood PS searched the area and found a rebar with cap LS19092 and set 3 reference ties. Monument fits 1977 corner record by Lyle Moseng, and agrees with the coordinate from the County Highway Department. Accepting as the corner location.*
